Thank you very much for your letter of August 1, 1992 which I received after I sent a fax to PETA.

I don't think TBS will object to PETA's showing of the video to the Japanese Ambassador over there. If you have any difficulty in obtaining permission from TBS, JAVA (Ms Nogami) might be able to help.

I have sent out all the protest postcards. As I wanted to send a few cards to one addressee, I have run out of the cards and couldn't send to the 8 individuals in Australia and ANZFAS (but since you have already sent the cards to ANZFAS, I think I have covered all.)

Ms Teresa Gibbs and I have exchanged letters before regarding Sarumawashi. I promised to send her a video of sarumawashi featuring Taro Murasaki and the monkey Jiro as one of JAVA members said she could arrange, but so far she hasn't succeeded.

I'm sure PETA will support you 100%, but not so sure about WSPA. Mr. Wim de Kok, by the way, might have moved to their London HQ by now. I hope WSPA in Holland will forward your petition to him c/o London Office.

Could you please send me about 60 protest postcards? I'd like to ask our members to be present at our next monthly meeting to sign them and send out to the Governor of Nara.
