Town Alert! Alaskan Malamute on the loose.

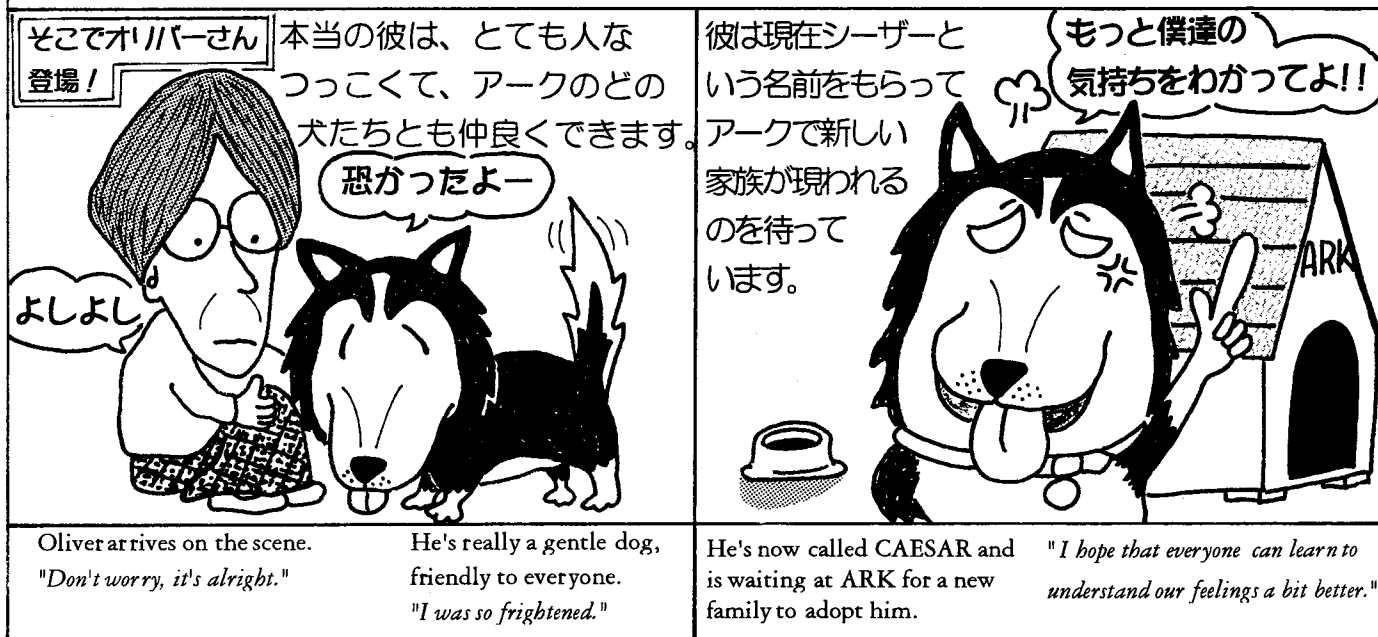
4 patrol cars and 12 policemen rush to the scene.

"I was so frightened."

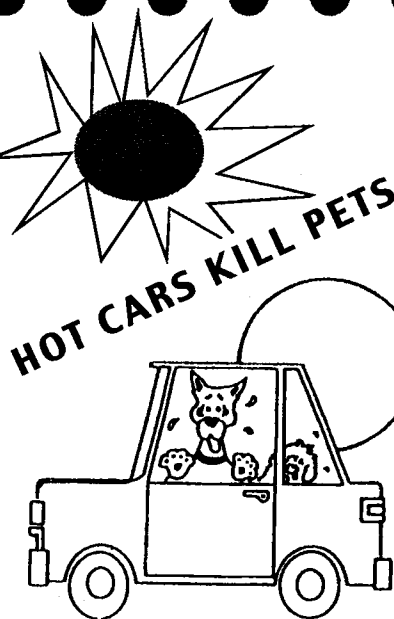
He's now called CAESAR and is waiting at ARK for a new family to adopt him.
