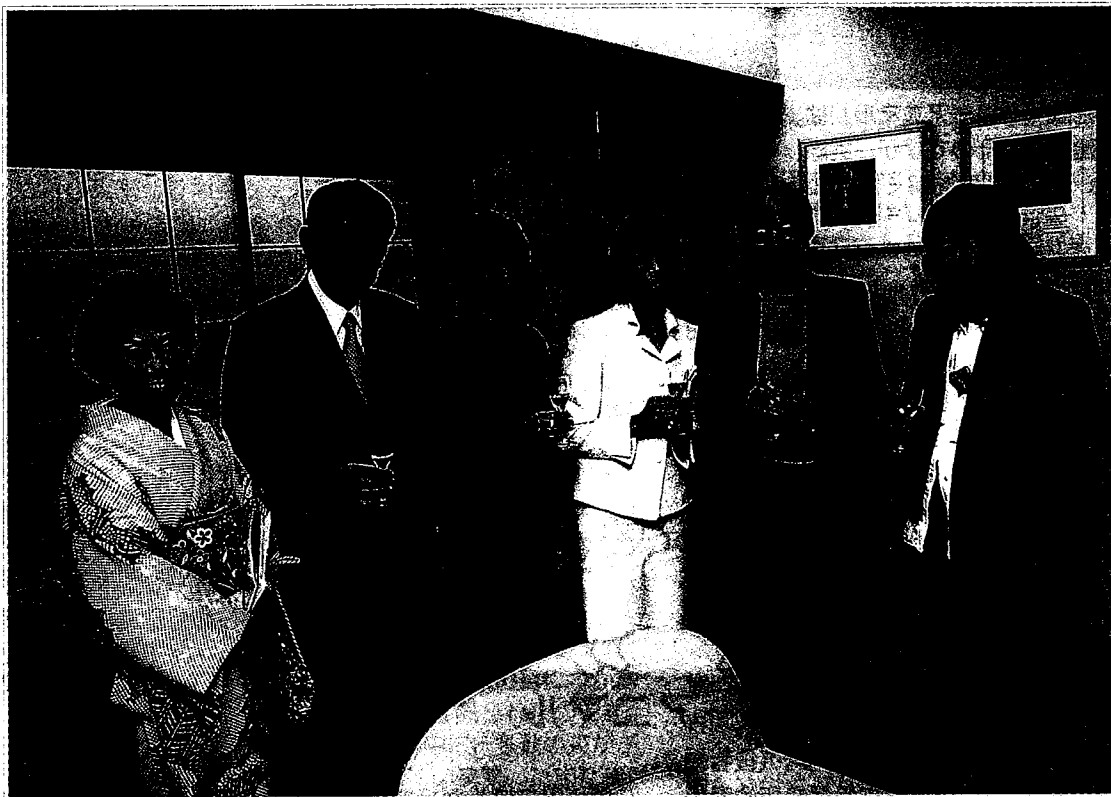




New Year's Eve at Osaka Festival Hall 大晦日の夜に大阪フェスティバルホールにて、
