'Last year we adopted Special, now renamed Momo, from ARK and Oliver san brought her to Ehime (in Shikoku) by airplane. This April we revisited ARK together.

When Momo, who has one front leg missing, first arrived, she was very over-anxious and fearful. She remained hidden in her kennel, not allowing us to touch her and never eating when we were around. After two weeks we tried to take her out of the kennel but she totally panicked and to our shock escaped through the gate. We chased after her but she had disappeared. Although we searched everywhere we couldn't find her that day.

The following day we started the search in earnest. We put up posters, adverts in the newspaper, asked everyone; newspaper delivery boys, police, hokensho, city office officials, milk deliverymen, electrical company employees and an animal professional who thought she might be heading back to Osaka and ARK. So the search area became much wider. We could only hope and pray she would come back.

On the fifth day there was a call, " she's in my garden." We rushed to the caller's house. I was trembling with happiness to see her again. She kept running away when I tried to touch her. This happened several times so I decided to grab her. She started biting my hand, I suppose out of self-defence and finally the pain made me loose my grip of her. My husband wasn't at home and the caller, an old woman, was of no help so I rang the police but all they said was " Catch her yourself, it's your dog." I asked the old woman to shut the gate so Momo couldn't escape. Now in great pain and almost fainting I called an

ambulance.

After treatment at the hospital I reached home and although it was 2 am, I called the animal professional who said she'd go first thing in the morning. I hardly slept, worrying about Momo. In the morning she arrived with a puppy in tow, (use a dog to catch a dog) and was successful in catching Momo. So after such drama, Momo came home again.

When Momo had originally arrived from ARK, she never barked but after her escape she began to bark. I think she finally feels at home with us. My hand took over a month to heal but I believe it was a test God gave me to live without one hand, like Momo.

I think Momo's escape was a good lesson for us, we will never push her to do something too quickly. The neighbours are very friendly and ask ," what happened to her leg," while some school kids call "Momo-chan," when they pass the house and say " that dog's cool, she's got guts." Momo seems to listen to what they are saying about her. She has lots of doggy friends and will sit and wait for them to come up to her. Through Momo we have made a lot of new friends and I like to think of this as the 'Momo effect.' Momo loves to go out in the car, even to the vet, where she is well-behaved, though she clings to me like her mother.

Momo was happy to return to ARK on our visit. The round trip was 800 kilometres. This homecoming strengthened our relationship and we like to feel that Momo has two homes, ARK and ours. We want to tell you how much Momo means to us, how much happiness she gives us and how much we love her.
