

Cruelty beyond measure

TAKAMATSU — In a savage attack last week, a trio of 1 to 2-month-old puppies each had a front paw cut off, local residents told the Mainichi.

A man gave the canine victims first aid before rushing them to an animal hospital, and they are now in good condition.

Judging from the severed parts, the attacker cut off the paws by binding them tightly with wire, he said.

The man, 26, who did not want to be named, said a friend of his had found the three dogs and another, which was only slightly injured, left in a cardboard box on the bank of Koto River in Takamatsu last Tuesday.

He took in the puppies and plans to keep them at his home in Shido, Kagawa Prefecture, until he finds suitable homes for them.
