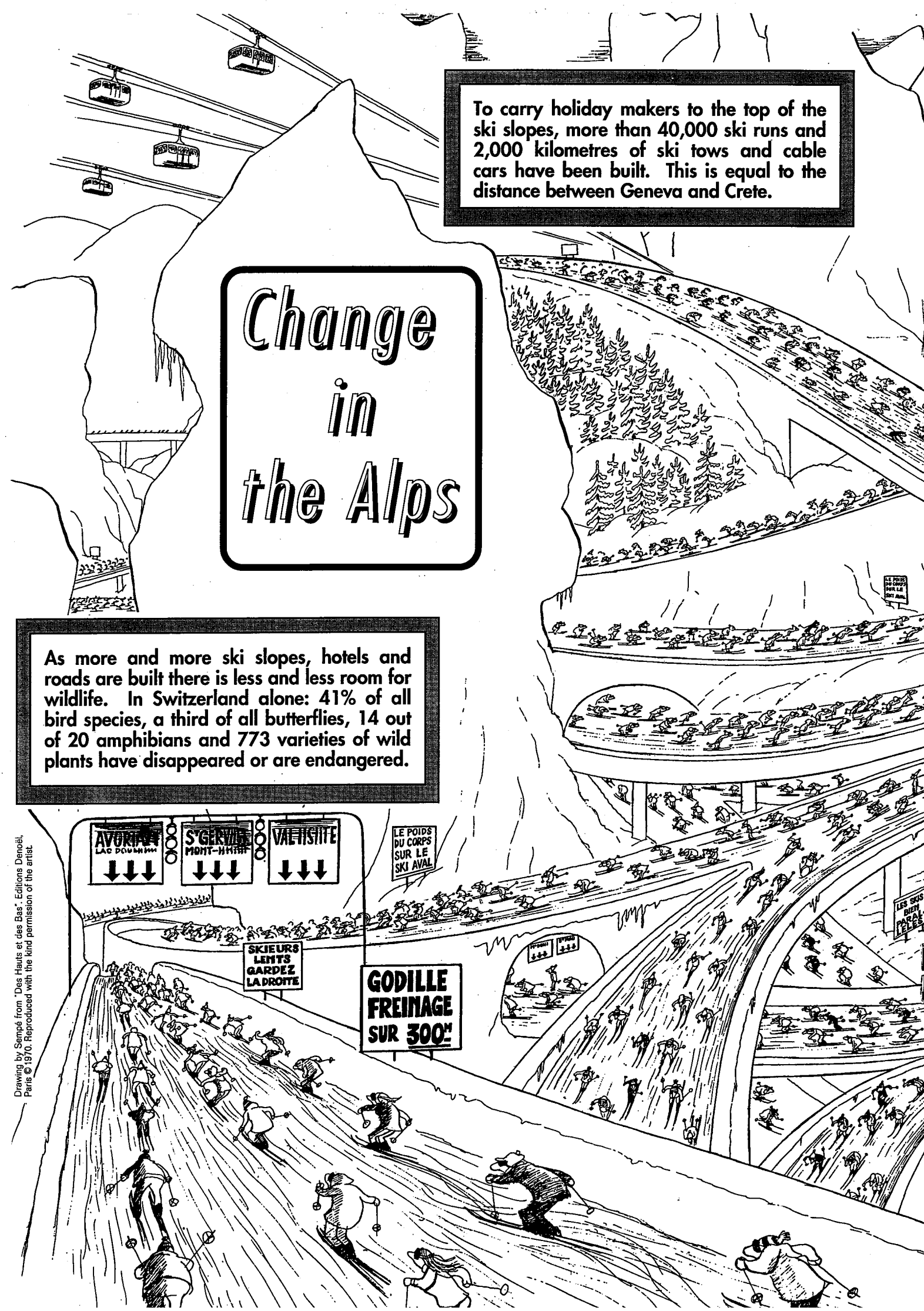




To carry holiday makers to the top of the ski slopes, more than 40,000 ski runs and 2,000 kilometres of ski tows and cable cars have been built. This is equal to the distance between Geneva and Crete.

Change in the Alps

As more and more ski slopes, hotels and roads are built there is less and less room for wildlife. In Switzerland alone: 41% of all bird species, a third of all butterflies, 14 out of 20 amphibians and 773 varieties of wild plants have disappeared or are endangered.
