

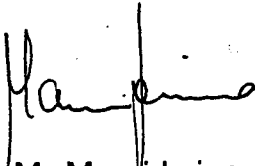
• Finnish fur farming. Demand them to favour clothes without any fur and try to get them to understand that there are a lot of other materials, which could be used instead of furs.

Finland is specialized to farm foxes (60 % of fox furs in the world come from Finland), so it is reasonable to concentrate on fox furs. Minks are commonly farmed too, but farming of them has already been uneconomical for years (costs of reproducing mink furs are much bigger than incomes from it).
