Ueno Zoo Sets Panda Service For Sept. 20

Tokyo's Ueno Zoo will hold "funeral services" for Lan Lan, a female giant panda which died on Aug. 4, and 314 other animals of 111 species which died there during the past year,

at 1.30 p.m. on Sept. 20.

Memorial addresses will be delivered by, among others, Huang Hsing, first secretary of the Embassy of China which had sent a pair of pandas to the zoo, and a representative of an elementary school nearby. Some 100 will be read from among the 2,000 telegrams of condolence sent from across the country after the death of the panda.

An orangutan is scheduled to lead the dedication of flowers to

the dead animals.
