A horse is winched up through the decks by its hind legs. It is still alive, but only just. Its body, covered in wounds, was then dumped on the deck where it lay shaking until its death.

That horse was just one of 900 equines shipped from Argentina to Italy. Five died en route. (It is usually many more.) Many of those that did survive were in appalling condition.

For years now, British legislation has prevented our horses from suffering the same fate. But by 1992, that legislation is to be replaced by new EC regulations. Regulations which will make it legal to transport our equines for hundreds of miles for slaughter. The result is likely to be horrific. The ILPH are the leading international equine charity and we are righting to retain legislation. Time is running out and we need your support now.
