Osaka Photo Show Focuses On Pain Of Vivisection

A group campaigning for the abolition of animal experimentation has organized an exhibition of grim photographs in Shinsaibashi, Osaka, to push their message home.

The Japanese Anti-Vivisection Association has collected about 40 photographs of animals undergoing laboratory testing and will exhibit

them at Gallery Hakucho.

The association estimates that as many as 20 million mammals are used in laboratory experiments annually in Japan. Guinea pigs, rabbits, cats and abandoned dogs and monkeys captured from the wild are tortured or killed in medical experimentation and product testing.
