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THE OBJECTIVE OF THE SOCIETY

The main objective of the society is active animal protection work and to study and develop companionship between animal and humans and to contribute to establishing a loving, and peaceful society. The society promotes the following activities.

1. Protecting animals from suffering.
2. Animal welfare campaign to prevent cruelty to animals.
3. Studying researching and promoting companionship-partnership between animals and people.
4. Creating a permanent KAPS office building and a sanctuary with proper facilities for education, neuter surgery, and protecting abused and abandoned animals.
5. Publishing printed material on animal protection and education.
6. Educating and promoting sterilization (neuter surgery) to reduce the number of abandoned animals.
7. Fund raising for the above activities.
8. Promoting projects for the welfare and protection of animals in Korea and throughout the world in co-operation with IFAW.

THE KOREAN ANIMAL PROTECTION LAW

The most important task was the passing of the Korea animal protection law through the National Assembly. IFAW and KAPS made great efforts in working closely with the Korean government to achieve this goal. It was approved by the government at the end of 1990 and finally passed through the National Assembly on May 7th of 1991.

IMPORTANT POINTS OF THE LAW

1. The law states that the purpose is to provide the adequate protection and management of animals by preventing their mistreatment.
2. No one should kill animals in a way which is cruel or which provokes disgust without proper, rational, and logical reasons.
3. Animals shall not be subject to the infliction of unnecessary pain or injury.
