She calls it "farm" and we, my neighbour who adopted one of her dogs, were deeply touched about the Center.

Miss Oliver has meanwhile about 200 animals mainly unwanted dogs, cats, goats, geese and a pony. (vide report)

It is such a spacey happy place and we only wonder how she - with only one help - can manage to keep the animals and the land with so much care and love.

Naturally people keep bringing unwanted pets to her and we only can guess her sorrow that she has to give in and take some of the overflow to the Rescue Center for euthanasia.

She is working hard also in the educational field and we pray that JAWS can get the Government to implement effective laws and subsidize spaying programs which would be the only way to solve the problem.

I am looking forward to your visit to the Kansai - I can accommodate 5 people in the car (the driver, three ladies and me) to make the two hours trip to Nose. It is a worthwhile experience.
